The EBLIDA approach to SDGs

- A European approach
- Not calling for stories to tell (450 SDG stories in France), but for stories linked to policies and assessed through indicators
- The EBLIDA Sustainable Development House which enables administrators (library and not, at national / local level) (EBLIDA Matrix)



Four false myths



SDG-oriented library projects:

- do not fall within the library's core mission, no stories to tell, but stories linked to policies and assessed through indicators
- are of an environmental nature,
- concern mainly fiscal and legislative macro-policies and
- fit small-scale, locally based projects of demonstrative nature.

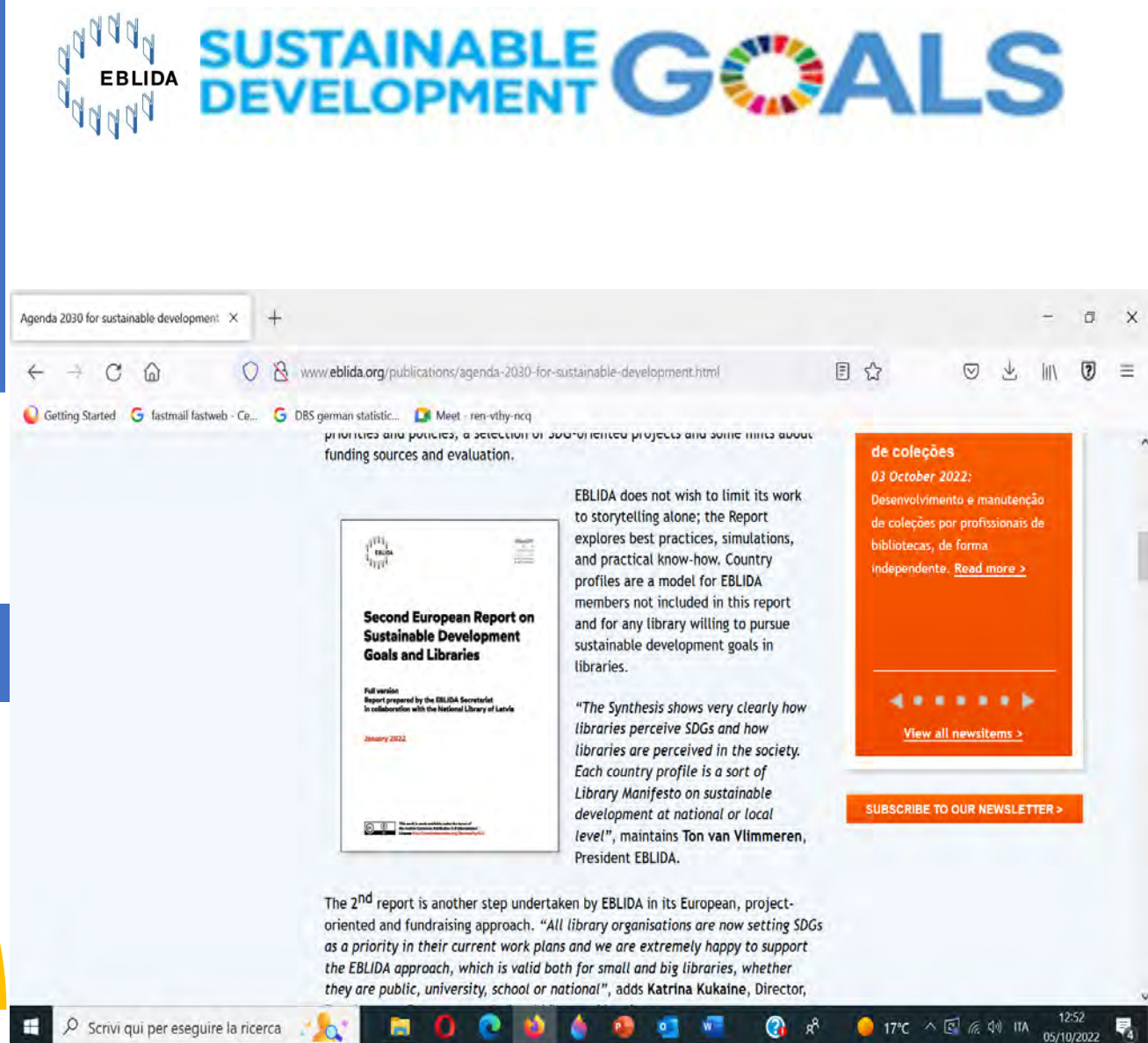

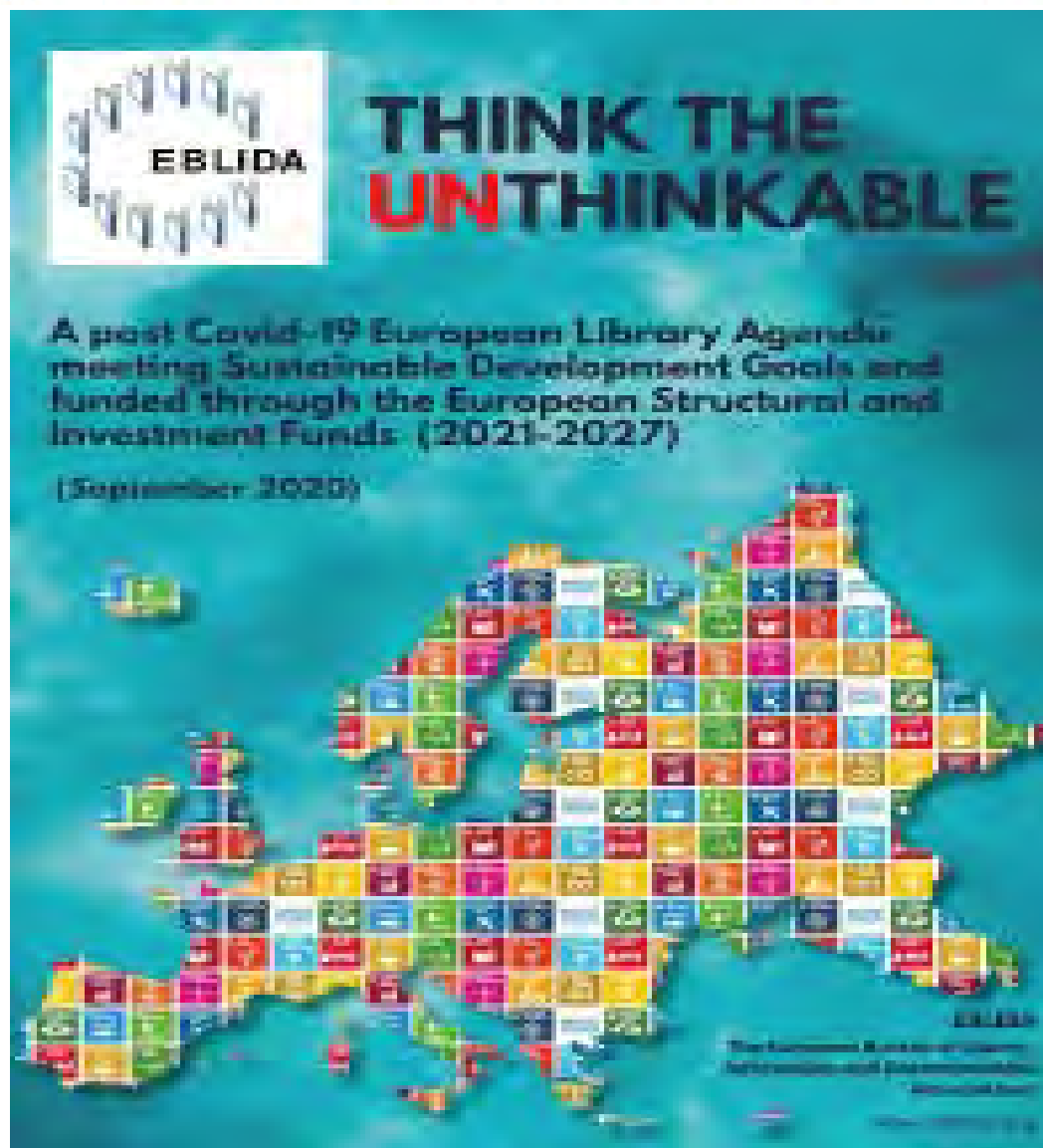

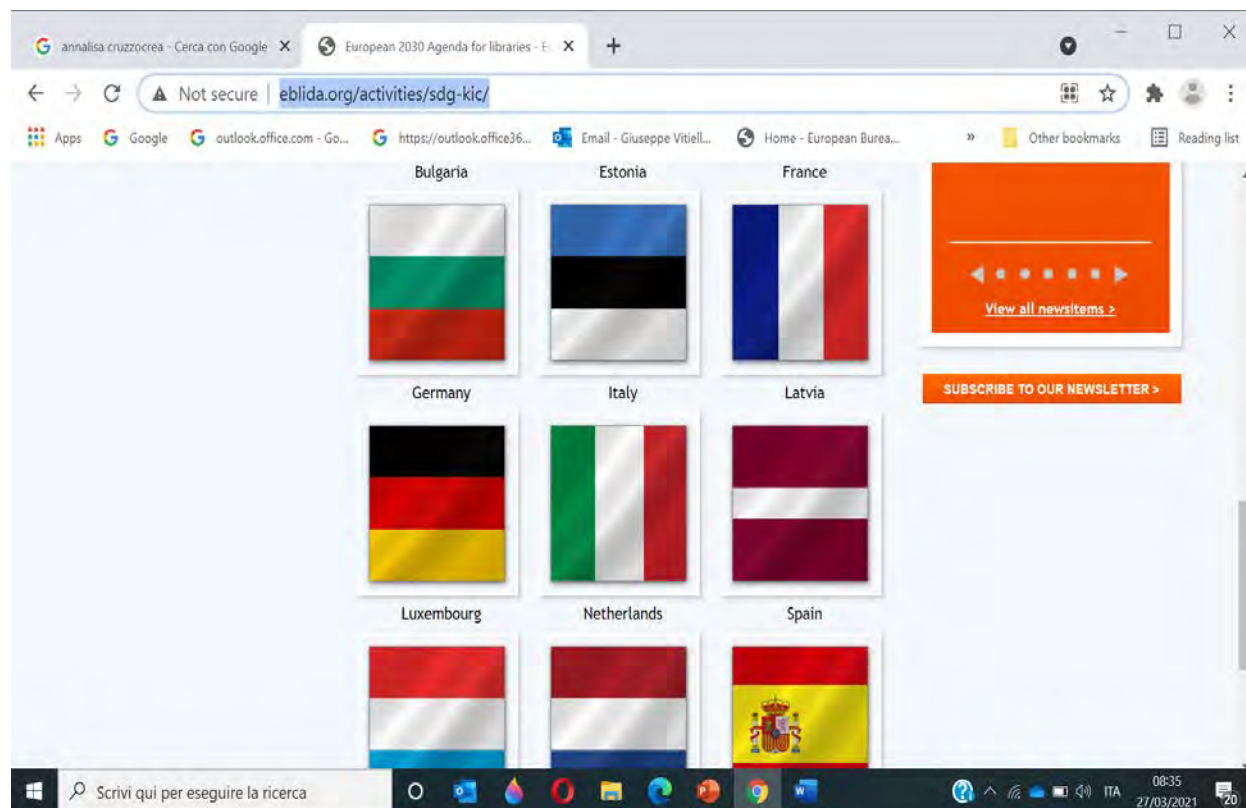

We are very pleased to inform you that the House has just published a training tool: the [“European Structural and Investment Funds \(ESIF\) 2021-2027: a Guide for library applicants”](#).



The EU provides plenty of financial opportunities, both direct (Horizon, Erasmus, etc.) and indirect. ESI Funds are the most important source of European indirect funding. They target not only hard infrastructure (railway corridors, motorways, broadband wirelines, and subsidies to farmers, to name but a few) but also a more cohesive Europe taking into account the cultural dimension. This is an incredible opportunity that libraries should not jeopardize.

“The advantage for libraries to resort to ESI Funds is that the programs are administered at national level, oriented towards communities, adaptable to small as well as big library initiatives and are in general adequately funded”, says Ton van Vlimmeren, EBLIDA President.

WHY ESIF 2021- 2027?

EBLIDA selected ESIF 2021-2027 for the following reasons:

- a) the R&D requirement in ESIF projects is not essential; there is room for small as well as big libraries;
- b) programmes are administered at national level; no complex networks at European level;
- c) libraries, and in particular public libraries, are strongly connected with local communities, and so do ESI Funds;
- d) ESIF normally accounts for one third of the whole EU budget.

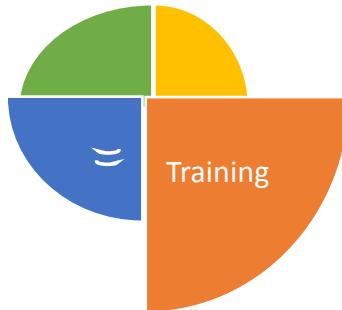


