Library - Culture hub



Digital culture hub (knowledge hub)

- What are the needs of citizens?
- Who will be the trainers?
- What will be the financial resources?
- How will it be implemented at the library level?

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Citizens' needs:

I. Basic knowledge (how to use a PC)

- Brief description of PC, mobile, tablet, laptop hardware; how to start and how to shut down (ON/OFF)
- Windows: tree organization of files, the search function by name, the role of file extensions, how to save a file and where.
- Office applications: word, excel, power-point. Copy-paste function

II. Up-date basic knowledge

- Internet browsing: a few kind of browsers, google, how to make an email account.
- Other sites: News, Agriculture, sports, cuisine, TV programs, streaming, social media
- Communication applications: zoom, Webex, google-meet, Microsoft teams
- Consulting sites for different documents: how to upload and how to download

III. Learning about free digital services for them (interfaces with public administrations)

- Description of some Payment Sites: commercial and utilities;
- Creating user accounts and retaining passwords
- Making payments and taxes electronically on the dedicated websites (CEZ/e-on, Engie, Digi/ Vodafone/ Orange, County water companies, "ghiseul.ro" for taxes, bank websites)

IV. Learning about getting information via internet (data bases, research engines, etc.)

- Internet search engines, information filtering
- Content organizing and disemination

V. Special knowledge (data protection, cyber-security, data privacy etc.)

• Electronic signature, GDPR measures, data security, anti-phishing measures, saving data on external media

VI. High-level knowledge (data meaning, AutoCAD, graphic design, media editing)



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

Distribution by county of the total number of public libraries









The county distribution of the employees in the IC&T field

Financial resources:

- Public funds (libraries)
- Private founds (companies which need personal or IT companies)
- Institutional agreement between library and schools and universities (with an agreement of local / central authorities)
- Financed projects by National Recovery and Resilience Plan







Conclusions

- The ICT citizens' skills represent a great necessity in Romania
- The district Libraries can offer an appropriate environment for ICT knowledge developing and digital hubs
- Most medium and small libraries have to be supported trough ICT infrastructure improving
- The library human resources have not enough competences for ICT teaching at the all levels
- There is ICT human resources for training outside of libraries
- Financial resources could be find if it is a clear objective and strategic plan
- There is not a strategy at national level dealing with digital transformation of libraries and ICT skills developing of citizen
- All actors central & local administration, schools & universities, private sectors,
 NGO have to cooperate to touch the main objective: increasing the ICT citizens skills, based on Library-Hubs.
